## *How Our Record Is Calculated*

Just as in Football, our basketball record is based on Unit Play. The big difference with Basketball is that the vast majority of games are Regular Plays. The line comes into play in Football about 30% of the time. With Basketball, it's around 43%. And with hoops, it's pretty much an every day game and the season is longer. Usually, just a couple of players on a team will account for 40% - 50% of the teams total offense. If one of those players gets hot- or if one of those players has a fight with his girlfriend, it's the difference between covering and not covering. We'll have 15 - 20 Triple Plays each year in Hoops and possibly one or two Five Star Plays, but almost all of our Basketball Plays will be Regular Plays. Just as in Football, the single most important thing is sports wagering is to play what you feel comfortable playing, regardless of how anyone rates a game.
